Activity Title – Industrial Visit

Objective

The industrial visit was organized to provide first-year BCA students with practical exposure to the IT industry and to bridge the gap between academic learning and real-world applications.

The visit aimed to familiarize students with:

- The corporate working environment of a multinational IT company
- Software development processes and project life cycles
- Emerging technologies and career opportunities in the IT sector
- Professional ethics, teamwork, and workplace culture

• Description of the Visit

UST is a global digital transformation solutions company that provides services in cloud computing, data analytics, cybersecurity, artificial intelligence, and enterprise software development. With a strong presence at Technopark, Thiruvananthapuram, UST is known for its innovation-driven approach and people-centric work culture.

The industrial visit commenced at 10.00 a.m. with a warm welcome by the UST representatives. The students were introduced to the organization's vision, mission, and global presence. This was followed by an informative session on the role of information technology in solving real-world problems and the importance of skills such as programming, communication, and adaptability.

The technical session provided insights into software development methodologies, including Agile practices, project management tools, and quality assurance processes. Students were

also briefed on emerging technologies such as artificial intelligence, cloud services, and data-driven decision-making.

An interactive session allowed students to ask questions regarding career paths, required skill sets, internships, and placement opportunities. The visit concluded with a guided walkthrough of selected workspaces, giving students a glimpse of the professional work environment at UST.
